Dear Kindergarten Families,

Here is a list of a few supplies that is asked of each kindergarten family to purchase for the 2021-2022 school year. Please bring these items on the first day of school.

## **Please purchase and bring in the following required items:**

- Backpack (regular sized) *-label with child's name on inside*
- Lunch box *-label with child's name*
- 1 reusable, leak-proof Water Bottle *-label with child's name* (instead of water fountains)
- 1 plastic 5"x8" Crayon/Supply Box *-label with child's name*
- 1 pack of 24-count Crayola Washable Crayons
- 4 Elmer's Washable Glue Sticks
- 1 pair of blunt-tipped, metal child-sized Scissors *-label with child's name*
- 1 chisel-tip black dry erase marker
- 1 chisel-tip yellow highlighter

### ***Please bring only the above supplies.***

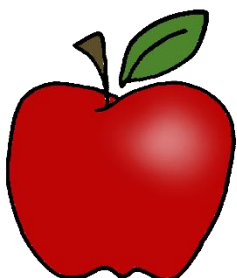
*Other supplies such as pencils, erasers, and folders will be supplied as needed.*

## Kindergarten Readiness Checklist

### I'm ready for K when I can...

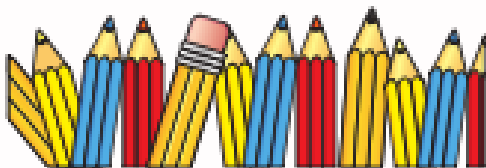
#### Academics:

- Recite alphabet
- Identify all upper and lower case letters
- Identify numbers 1-10 or higher
- Count to 30 or higher
- Write first and last name in correct cases
- Write all upper and lower case letters and numbers 1-10
- Count objects, touching each object as they count
- Identify basic colors
- Sort objects by color
- Identify basic shapes
- Identify basic patterns
- Recognize simple rhyming words (cat-bat)



#### Motor Skills:

- Hold a pencil and crayon correctly
- Hold scissors correctly and cuts appropriately
- Color in the lines appropriately



#### Social/ Emotional Skills

- Follow a multi-step direction
- Use bathroom without assistance
- Wait for a turn
- Sit quietly and listen for at least 10-15 minutes at a time
- Show self-control in play
- Get along well with others/ share
- Express feelings appropriately
