Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten

To ensure your child has the best possible experience at Rhema—without the worry of staining a special outfit or injuring their toes—please review the list of clothing guidelines below. These requirements help keep your child safe and comfortable during their day.

Please note: Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students are not required to follow the school's official dress code policy until they enter Kindergarten.

Clothing Guidelines for Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten

To help your child stay safe, comfortable, and ready for fun, please follow the clothing guidelines below:

- Fridays are spirit days! Students should wear a Rhema t-shirt, sweatshirt, or hoodie.
- Dresses or skirts must be worn with bike shorts or leggings underneath.
- No Crocs or open-toed shoes (such as sandals or flip-flops) are allowed. For safety, athletic shoes are preferred every day.
- Athletic shoes are required on gym days.
- Your child's teacher will provide a Ziploc bag for an extra set of clothes to be kept at school in case of spills or accidents.
